Departure from Palais des Congrès of Juan-les-Pins on foot

Arrival Ponteil Beach and Panorama

Guided Tour of Old Antibes

Option: Absinthe tasting with tapenade

Total Duration: 2h + 30 minutes with tasting

Discover on foot the fascinating history of the city of Antibes, founded by the Greeks and fortified under Henry IV and Louis XIV. You'll admire the beauty of its medieval town, its seaside ramparts, the Château Grimaldi-Picasso Museum, the Provençal market halls, its famous Vauban port, and its flowery Safranier district. Take a short break in a superb, vaulted cellar in Old Antibes with Frédéric, who will reveal the history and secrets of absinthe, the cursed drink and muse of artists.

Guided Tour of Juan-les-Pins

Option: Tea-time at the Mauresque ("Moorish") Villa Djunah (and visit of the villa but subject to availability) or at Juana hotel

Free Return

Total duration: 2h + 30 minutes with Tasting

A discovery of the resort's history, from its creation in the 19th century to the present day.

You'll admire the hidden beauties of Juan-les-Pins, which already captivated Maupassant and Monet during their stays on the coast: the Belle Époque villas and their lush gardens, the palaces and dance halls of the Années Folles ("Crazy Years") and the celebrities who frequented them, the Pine Park Gould and its jazz stars...

You'll end on a high note with afternoon tea in one of the resort's renowned establishments: the surprising Moorish Villa Djunah and its oriental gardens OR the Juana Hotel, a magnificent 1930s Art Deco building (subject to availability).
